

Bible Translation	Style	Why It's Helpful
<i>What speaks most deeply to me?</i> NRSV (New Revised Standard Version) <i>Here are some suggested translations:</i>	Thoughtful & inclusive	<u>Official translation of the Episcopal & Anglican Church</u> Excellent for study, widely used in liturgy and theological education
<i>NIV (New International Version)</i>	<i>Balanced</i>	<i>Clear, widely used, great for study and group reading</i>
<i>KJV (King James Version)</i>	<i>Formal & poetic</i>	<i>Rich in tradition and literary beauty, great for memorization</i>
<i>ESV (English Standard Version)</i>	<i>Literal</i>	<i>Great for word-by-word study and theological depth</i>
<i>The Message</i>	<i>Paraphrased & poetic</i>	<i>Fresh, contemporary language that brings emotional resonance</i>
